Tuition

- Lessons and Ensemble: \$1600
- Ensemble-only: \$450 (for students taking private lessons elsewhere)

Note: tuition includes 28 (45-minute) lessons, 25 ensemble classes, and at least 3 performances. All STMS ensemble students are also invited to participate in the annual Music Pal Project, which includes several community events throughout the school year.

Note: parents are not required to attend lessons but are still expected to maintain a "Practice Partner" role at home—helping students maintain a productive daily practice routine.

Payment

- First installment (50% tuition) is due by **September 7th**.
- Second installment (remaining tuition) is due by January 4th.
- Tuition must be received before students can begin lessons.
- Payment through **Venmo** (@CaitlinVeronin) is preferred, but checks are also accepted (made out to <u>Caitlin Veronin</u> and bring to the main office).

Scheduling and Make-Up Lessons

- Lessons will take place on **Thursdays** on a rotating schedule.
- Ensemble rehearsals will take place Thursdays during advisory period.
- Students are responsible for remembering their lesson time and informing Mrs. V a **week in advance** regarding any academic conflicts (tests, quizzes, presentations, etc.).
- Students who forget their instruments cannot participate in ensemble or private lessons.
- Up to 3 lessons can be rescheduled if missed due to instructor absence, school closure, illness, or other excused absences. Lessons missed due to unexcused absences, last minute academic conflicts, or forgotten instruments cannot be rescheduled.
